PARKING:

Gates will be up. Parking is included.

ENTRY FEES:

- The entry fee will be \$16 per individual event and \$24 per relay
- School Amounts will be posted to ONTRACK.COM when all scratches and advancements are confirmed
- Cheques are to be made to "**STRATFORD DISTRICT SECONDARY SCHOOL**"
- This amount will also cover your OFSAA WEST REGIONAL FEES. You will not be required to request a second cheque for this event. As the Convenor, Kerry will take one cheque to Windsor which will cover all of our Association's entrance fees.

QUALIFIERS:

- Advancers will be listed on your "School Advancer" list posted on WWW.ONTRACK.COM
- If you have any scratches after WOSSAA, please inform Franco ASAP so athletes can be filled in and alerted

COACH REQUIREMENTS:

- On Day One of WOSSAA (Thursday May 23) between 8:00-9:00 am, all WOSSAA T&F coaches need to bring their cheque to the registration table where they can pick up their team package and receive a receipt (if required)

COACHES' MEETING:

There will be a brief coaches' meeting at 9:00 am sharp. This will be outside of the results shed.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Each conference will be responsible for officiating or helping with certain events.
- Please complete the sign up form by **Sunday May 19th**

- Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the event. Pick up your athlete list and any necessary equipment from the results shed.
- We will have some extra tape measures for officials to use; however please try your best to bring your own
- Lunch will be provided for any adults who officiate. This will be served in the Visitor's Changeroom.

WEIGH-INS:

- Weigh-ins should be done first thing in the morning. Weather permitting, weigh-ins will be done down near the javelin area. If the weather is poor, we will relocate inside the shed.
- **Weigh-ins will only be available from 9:00 am until 10:00 am** each morning.

MARSHALLING:

- Marshalling for all Field Events will take place at the competition site.
- Coaches and spectators are expected to stay out of this area and may watch from the grass. Discus is located outside the stadium. Coaches and spectators are asked to stay behind the caged area..
- Marshalling for all Track Events will take place at the start line of each race. Athletes will be marshaled just 15 minutes prior to their event.
- Athletes will be allowed to warm up on the back stretch of the track when not in use

Absolutely no coaches, athletes or spectators will be allowed in the infield during the meet.

RESULTS/AWARDS:

- The results will be posted on the track shed at the south end of the stands
- Live Results are available at www.onttrack.com
- The Awards table will be located by the track shed

PROTESTS:

- Any protest must be made in writing and submitted to the WOSSAA Convenor, within 30 minutes of the results being posted. A \$100 deposit must accompany the protest and will be refunded if you win the protest.

ADVANCEMENT TO OFSAA WEST REGION:

- The **top 5 finishers** in each event shall advance to OFSAA West Region.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- **Spectators must remain in the stands.** Please do not stand at the railing.
- **TENTS** in the stands are not to be in the lower portion of the stands, in order to allow for maximum seating and viewing for vans. There is also plenty of greenspace around the stadium for team tents.
- First Aid will be available on-site. Thanks to Liana Leonard from Mosaic Medical in providing our WOSSAA T&F medical coverage.
- No portable stereo systems are allowed inside TD Waterhouse Stadium.
- No footballs, Frisbees, soccer balls, etc.
- Throwing implements may only be used in the designated completion areas.
- Athletes are reminded that absolutely **no club insignia** will be allowed in the competition areas.
- Student-athletes must remain fully clothed in the appropriate attire in the competition area, AND use the designated locker room or change area to change to and from competition attire.
- **FOOD:** The concession stand will be open and available for food and beverages.
- **GARBAGE:** Please encourage the use of trash containers. At the end of the meet, please ensure that your team area is clean and tidy.
