

MEET INFORMATION

Where: Alumni Stadium, Western University, London When: Thursday, May 15 - Friday, May 16, 2023

PARKING:

Gates will be up. Parking is free at TVRA, and you do not need to use the HONK app to pay.

ENTRIES:

- The entry fee is free and covered by TVRA
- Entries for TVRA MUST be received by Franco lelapi at RMC by Saturday, May 10 @ 11:59 pm
- Entries will be made through Trackie.
- Performance lists will be posted: Sunday, May 11
- Scratch deadline: Monday, May 12 @ 6:00 pm
- Athletes achieving top 10 results at TVRA will advance to WOSSAA

ELIGIBILITY:

2025 Playing Regulations

- TVRA/WOSSA eligibility lists must be uploaded to the TVRA website by the entry deadline.
- All athletes MUST participate in <u>16</u>-team practices and must compete in one exhibition meet to qualify for TVRA championships.
- Each school may enter up to 3 athletes per event, and up to 3 relay teams per event.
- Each athlete may enter in up to a maximum of 3 events, and a maximum of 2 relays.
- Starting heights for vertical jumps...back to normal (see playing reg's)
- Event Standards: Athletes must meet the posted qualification standards. If there is an event where no athlete makes the standard, you may enter one athlete in each event without meeting the standard.

COACHES MEETING:

- There will be a brief coaches' meeting at 9:00 am for announcements, updates or questions.
- This will be outside of the results shed.

EVENT RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Each conference will be responsible for certain event responsibilities. Please register for an event on the form using this link. https://docs.google.com/document/d/1hmdy5ieFTZa0KyqDLHluSc3LYGHijlssm9tsY12VRC0/edit?usp=sharing
- Please arrive at least 30 minutes prior to the event to pick up your athlete list and any equipment necessary.
- We will have tape measures and clipboards for officials to use, however, please try your best to bring your own.
- Lunch will be provided for all the adults who are officiating. This will also be served in the Visitor's Changeroom. (Student helpers receive volunteer hours for their efforts)

WEIGH-INS:

- Weigh-ins should be done at least an hour in advance of the event. Weigh-ins will be located near the javelin runway.
- The weigh-in station will close 1-hour before the last event, each day.

MARSHALLING:

- Marshaling for all Field Events will take place at the competition site.
- Coaches and spectators are expected to stay out of this area and may watch from the grass.
- Marshaling for all Track Events will take place near the start line of each race. Athletes will be marshaled 15 minutes prior to their event.
- Please limit athletes and coaches on the infield.
- Athletes will be allowed to warm up on the backstretch when not in use.



NUMBERS/UNIFORM:

- No bibs will be used at TVRA.
- Athletes must compete in their school uniforms. Relay team members must wear identical tops. The OFSAA Uniform policy will be in effect.

AWARDS:

The awards table will be located by the track shed.

PROTESTS:

Any protest must be made in writing and submitted to the WOSSAA Convenor within 30 minutes of the results being posted. A
 \$50 deposit must accompany the protest and will be refunded if you win the protest.

ADVANCEMENT TO WOSSAA:

- The top 10 finishers in each event shall advance to WOSSAA.
- Inform Franco lelapi of any scratches as soon as possible so that he can advance the next athlete to WOSSAA.
- WOSSAA Information can be found on the ONTTRACK.COM website when it becomes available.

TVRA SPIRITWEAR:

- Positive Identity will be on-site with souvenir sales on Thursday and Friday.

- Please share this link with your athletes. Orders are open until Tuesday, May 13, at midnight.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION:

- Spectators must remain in the stands. Please do not stand at the railing.
- Tents in the stand are not to be lower than halfway up the stands, in order to maximize seating and viewing for fans. There is
 also plenty of room in the greenspace around the stadium for team tents.
- First Aid will be available on-site by the door to the pavilion.
- No portable stereo systems are allowed inside Alumni Stadium.
- No footballs, Frisbees, soccer balls, etc.
- Throwing implements may only be used in the designated completion areas.
- Athletes are reminded that absolutely no club insignia will be allowed in the competition areas.
- Student-athletes must remain fully clothed in the appropriate attire in the competition area, AND use the designated washroom
 or change area to change to and from competition attire.
- **FOOD:** The concession stand will be open and available for food and beverages. Subway and Barakat Restaurants are available at the top of the hill along Western Road.
- **GARBAGE**: Please encourage the use of trash containers for depositing garbage. As the meet comes to an end, please ensure that your team area is clean and tidy.
- **EMERGENCY**: In case of a weather emergency, all athletes and coaches will be evacuated to the gymnasium in the Western Athletic Centre, across the street. Coaches are asked to sit with their team, and the meet will resume 30 minutes after the last sighting of lightning.
